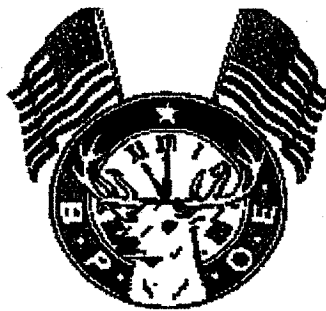



BPOE 85 TRUST FUND REPORT

Joe,

I have attached a list of items that we have purchased with your donation for the last two years. I hope this helps the other members see how much our program is benefitting from your help. We do have a balance in our fund, which is a very nice safety net if another need presents itself. This year, we are purchasing two classroom sound systems (still to be installed) and 3 Mimio interactive devices that turn whiteboards into smartboards. Both of these items are rather pricey, as you will notice. The classroom sound systems will be very beneficial to our students and we have wanted them for a long time. Two of our classrooms are getting them installed this year. We hope the others will get outfitted some time in the future. Research has shown that when a classroom has a sound system installed, there is improved academic achievement, as well as decreased distractibility, increased on-task behavior, and increased language growth, to name just a few of the benefits. We are truly thrilled to be able to have this available in two of our classrooms.

The Mimio is a portable device that attaches to any whiteboard, and with the use of a projector and computer, turns the whiteboard into a "smartboard." Essentially, this turns the whiteboard into a touch screen, enabling the teacher to create interactive lessons with the entire class. The mimiopad allows the teacher to control the computer and the whiteboard while wandering around the room. In this way, she can change activities or demonstrate an activity anywhere that is convenient. She doesn't have to walk over to the computer or the whiteboard to do it. Here is an example of a color sorting activity that we did in class. On the board, two bins might be showing, along with a variety of blue and red items. A student would come up and place a red item in the red bin or a blue item in the blue bin by placing a special pen on the board and dragging the item into the correct bin. If it is the correct color, it stays in the bin. If not, it bounces out, giving immediate feedback to the student and the entire class. Another activity we did this year was to "find the valentine" in various places around a room. When the student touched a valentine with the pen, it would become animated and move to another spot. The kids hardly moved throughout the activity as they tracked the valentine with their eyes. They didn't want to miss where it had gone. We were able to focus on prepositions, such as "under, next to, in front of" all the while having a great time. I've got to tell you, the kids LOVE it! They clamor for the opportunity to come up and interact with the board and the pen. It TRULY makes learning FUN! I've had a blast coming up with activities to use this device this year. There is really no end to the exciting things we can teach in this way.

Please convey our deepest appreciation to all members of the Elks organization. We truly understand how fortunate we have been to receive your donations year after year. We see the benefits every day as our students grow and develop as a result of your financial support. May your lives be blessed as well!
