Twentynine Palms Elks Lodge is planning a fun-filled weekend at the 25th Annual Funfest, October 21-23, 2011. The money raised at the Funfest will benefit the state major projects of Arizona, California-Hawaii, Nevada and Utah. The City of Twentynine Palms is located in the middle of the Mojave Desert between Los Angeles and the Colorado River. Twentynine Palms is home to the Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (largest in area) and gateway to the Joshua Tree National Park (celebrating their 75th anniversary this year).

The Lodge has 12 RV hookups with water and electricity. Spots may be reserved in advance on a first come, first served basis. A dump is on site. We will attempt to accommodate water and electricity if more than 12 units attend. There is also space for lots of dry camping. For those who prefer a motel/hotel, see the lodging sheet included with this information.

Friday and Saturday lunches as well as Friday and Saturday dinners will be available at the Lodge. See the Registration Sheet included for the breakdown and cost. During the lunches and dinners, we'll have 50/50 drawings -- half to winner, half to the charity pot.

Various activities have been planned starting with a golf tournament on Friday morning and Bingo Friday evening. There will be 'goofy golf' and 'golf fling' Saturday morning and a silent auction Saturday evening. It is requested that each couple or attendee bring two items for the auction. If time permits, washer boards and cribbage will be available Friday. There will be a \$2 per person entry fee for the games. The money collected for the games and auction will go in the charity pot. There will also be a 'Lazy Fundraiser' included in your registration packet.

Saturday night after dinner, there will be a dancing demonstration given by PER John King and the square dancers before the silent auction. At 10:00 AM Sunday morning, there will be a meeting of all participants to discuss where the next Funfest will be and checks presented to the states represented.
